

### Eligibility



**Open to 3**<sup>rd</sup> **& 4**<sup>th</sup> **Year undergraduate and Master's** students from overseas universities



- Attachment duration of 2 6 months at A\*STAR Research Institutes
- **Obtained/ on track to a Second-Class Upper Honours** (or equivalent) for bachelor's studies

Monthly stipend of S\$2,000

Annual Application Cycles 15 February | 15 June | 15 October

# **A\*STAR Research Attachment Programme (ARAP)**

- **Facilitates collaboration** between A\*STAR and overseas universities
- Supports international PhD students in overseas universities to undertake 1 - 2 years of research at an A\*STAR research institute under the **joint supervision** of an A\*STAR researcher and faculty member of home university
- PhD student remains matriculated at home university while physically based in an A\*STAR Research Institute (RI) throughout their attachment
- PhD degree will be conferred by the home university

# **A\*STAR Research Attachment Programme (ARAP)**

### Eligibility

**Open to all** international students



Bachelor's degree with at least a **Second-Class (Upper) Honours**

- Monthly stipend of S\$2,700 Monthly housing subsidy of S\$600 One-time airfare grant of S\$1,500 One-time settling-in allowance of S\$1,000 One-time IT allowance of S\$800

# Singapore International Graduate Award (SINGA)



- 4-year PhD scholarship for international BSc and MSc students in Singapore
- Pursue PhD in science, engineering, biomedicine and social sciences related to machine learning and artificial intelligence
- Perform cutting-edge research under distinguished researchers in A\*STAR, NTU, NUS, SUTD or SMU with degree being conferred by the university
